1. FAMILY SAYINGS:

- I can do it

2. 3 KEYS TO FAMILY LIFE:

- Positive attitude
- People skills
- Passive income with passion

3. FAMILY TRADITIONS:

- Respect
- Responsibility
- Resourcefulness

4. FAMILY LEGAL SYSTEM:

- **Peace:** Do not fight with your hands or words.
- **Asking:** Ask first or the answer is no. Tap on the shoulder once and then wait.
- **Order:** Put all things away. Use proper order or sequence.
- **Respect:** Be polite to everyone. Introduce yourself by shaking hands, looking people in the eye, and saying their name. "Nice to meet you, Mr. and Mrs. Smith."

- **Obedience:** You may ask why and we will try to tell you. Then you must do it.
- **Repenting bench:** Have an issue with a sibling? Sit on the bench and hash it out. A place for honing negotiation skills for peaceful resolutions.
